MISS AQUAFEST SCHOLARSHIP PAGEANT 2022

OFFICIAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Each contestant must be at least 5 years of age by April 1, 2022 and no older than 18 years of age.
2. Contestants must be single, female, never married, nor given birth to a child.
3. Contestants must be of good health and moral character.
4. The Miss Aquafest pageant is an ALL-NATURAL PAGEANT. Absolutely no make-up will be permitted for Tiny and Petite Divisions, Junior may wear very minimal make-up and Teen and Miss may wear age-appropriate make-up. Absolutely NO false eyelashes, flippers or wiglets or extensions, unless medically necessary. Points will be deducted from the contestants overall score for not following these guidelines.
5. All decisions as to eligibility shall be determined by Aquafest, Inc.
6. Miss Aquafest is open to contestants if they and or their parent(s), or guardian: reside or work in Snohomish County.
7. All decisions of the judges are final and irrevocable.
8. Any contestant and/or contestant's family members showing unsportsmanlike behavior will be disqualified. No refunds will be given, and the contestant will not be able to participate in the Miss Aquafest pageant in the future.
9. Aquafest, Inc. reserves the right to refuse a contestant, parents', guests' or relatives' entry, attendance and participation to the Miss Aquafest Pageant and/or any related workshops or events. Approval of contestant or contestants will not be unreasonably withheld.
10. Contestants hereby agree to release unconditionally and forever, any claim against Aquafest, Inc., the Miss Aquafest Scholarship Pageant, its officers, directors, volunteers, agents, subsidiaries, of which they may have, by virtue of their participation in this pageant. Or any use of their name, likeness, voice and/or biography in connection with this pageant, including use in promotional and advertising material.
11. Aquafest, Inc. reserves the right to change the date and location of the Miss Aquafest Pageant.
12. If for any reason a winner is disqualified, or elects not to participate, her title and all awards will be passed on to the next choice of the judges. Crowns, sashes, Royalty attire & awards are to be returned.
13. Board members of Aquafest, Inc. and members of their immediate families are eligible to participate in the competition. The exception is the immediate family of the pageant director and the Aquafest President. The immediate family of the aforementioned, may compete and be scored but may not hold the division title. Instead, these members may compete for the title of Miss Aquafest Ambassador, and Community Service Queen.
14. Contestants and their parents/guardians agree to hold harmless all persons affiliated with Aquafest, Inc and the Miss Aquafest Scholarship Pageant and its director, in case of any loss or injury occurring during, or in travel to and/or from this program.
15. The Community Service Queen title is only eligible to the previous year's royalty and will NOT be solely based on the number of hours dedicated to the community; it will also take into consideration the quality of service performed. Judges will also follow up with a phone call to the organization; or they may ask to speak to the contestant directly regarding their community service.

16. If applicable, recipients of the Aquafest titles promise to promote the program by attending the 4th of July parade in Everett, the Kla Ha Ya Days Parade in Snohomish, Aquafest Weekend activities, including the Children's Parade and the Grand Parade if held.
17. **Requirements**-All titleholders agree to participate in a minimum of 8 community service events with the Miss Aquafest Royalty group PLUS 4 community service events of their choosing with prior consent from Aquafest, Inc. Recipients further agree to attend the Miss Aquafest Royalty photoshoot in June 2022. **PLEASE NOTE THAT PARADES ARE NOT CONSIDERED COMMUNITY SERVICE.**
18. All titleholders further promise to make no personal appearances or appear in any advertising and/or publications without written permission from the Miss Aquafest Director and to return to the 2023 Miss Aquafest Scholarship Pageant to crown her successor.
19. Aquafest, Inc., and the Pageant Director reserves the right to combine or delete age divisions if less than 3 contestants per division. If age divisions are combined, delegates will still be scored according to their original age division rules.
20. Aquafest, Inc, reserves the right to adjust awards and prizes based on the number of delegates that have entered. Title winners Tiny and Petite will receive a cash award of one hundred dollars (\$100), Junior and Teen will receive a cash award of one hundred and fifty dollars (\$150). The Miss Aquafest Division will receive a cash award of four hundred dollars (\$400). Cash awards will be distributed in 2023. **Scholarships will only be distributed to title holders once the requirements have been met.**
21. **Payments must be PAID IN FULL at the time of registration.** Absolutely no refunds will be given after March 13, 2022 NO LATE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED.
22. **FINAL DATE FOR REGISTRATION IS March 13, 2022.** ALL PAYMENTS AND ENTRIES MUST BE RECEIVED BY THEN.
23. A \$30.00 dollar NSF Fee will be charged for any returned checks or credit card payments.

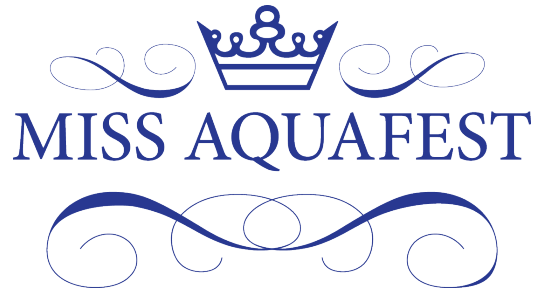
